

Public Holidays

- New Year's day: Jan. 1st
- Lunar New Year's holidays: Dec. 31st, Jan. 1st, and Jan 2nd in lunar calender. Most places are closed during this New Year's holidays. During this time many people come to visit their families hometown, all relatives gather to honor their ancestors with traditional rituals, and bow to their elders 「sebae」.
- Independence Movement Day: March 1st, a day to commemorate the independence movement on March 1st against colonial Japanese rule.
- Buddha's Birthday: April 8th in lunar calendar. This holiday is held in honor of Buddha's birth, and colorful ceremonies are held in Buddhist temples.
- Children's day: May 5th. This is a day for children. People give children presents, or go to picnic with them.
- Memorial Day: June 6th. This holiday is held to remember the war dead. Memorial services are held throughout the country, and many people visit the National Cemetery in Seoul, bringing flowers and special food.
- Independence Day: August 15th. This holiday celebrates liberation from Japan after 35 years of colonial rule.
- Chuseok holidays: August 14th, 15th, and 16th in lunar calendar. This is one of the most important festivals like New Year's day in Korea. However, people do not 「sebae」 on Chusok unlike Lunar New Year's day.
- National Foundation Day: October 3rd. This day marks the founding of Korea by the founder, Tan-qun, in 2333 B.C.
- Hangul Day: The day for the excellence of honor of Hangul(Korea) and celebration of Hangul invention
- Christmas: December 25th. In general, Christians love to hold a grand celebration of Christmas.

Other Holidays

- Election Day: This is a public holiday to allow people to vote.
- Labor Day: May 1st. This is a holiday held only for those in the work force. Banks and most companies close for the day. However, public servants are expected to work, and teachers and students must go to school on this day.

SCHOOL FACILITIES



Dormitory (on-campus housing)

- •Single room(very small number of vacancies), double room, quad room are available.
- •International students can choose 5 days meal(per week) option, 7 days meal options or no meal option.
- •In dormitory cafeteria, only Korean food will be served (lots of pork and spicy food, no halal food).
- •Kitchen for international students is available.
- •Students have to change dormitory room for every semester and every vacation (4 times a year).
- •Students staying in dormitory must submit TB test result for one time a year.
- •Each room, we have bed, desk, chair, closet
- dormitory fee (for 15 weeks, a semester)

Accommodation (outside of campus)

- •Near the campus, there are many real estate agencies which can help you to rent your own apartment.
- •There are lots of studio apartments near the campus. (5 mins to campus by foot or bus)

Cafeteria

•There are three cafeterias on campus. One cafeteria is located inside the dormitory and is only for dormitory residents. The other two are available to everyone, and serve Korean, Chinese, and western style foods. Prices range from 2,000KRW to 4,500KRW per meal.

•A Book café is centrally located on campus and offers hot and cold beverages and snacks at a reasonable price.

Bank

•There is a bank (Nonghyup Bank) located on campus. You can open your bank account, exchange currency and transfer currency domestically and overseas at this bank.

Convenience Store

•You can purchase daily supplies at one of several convenience stores on campus. Convenience stores are also located in several dormitories.

Sports facilities

•Gym, Tennis courts, Ping Pong, Soccer/Football stadium, Futsal stadium, Golf club are all located on campus. Use of some facilities, such as the golf club, require fees.

PART-TIME WORK



Part-time work for international students

- •International students who hold D-2 Visa can have opportunity to do part-time work in Korea during one's study period.
- •According to Korean immigration rules and regulations, all international students must report one's part-time work to local immigration office.
- •Allowed working hours (as from 2018.10.)

- •Allowed working places and categories: Translation, serving at restaurant or coffee shops, simple office work assistant (Any kind of teaching, teaching assistant or lecturing activity is strictly prohibited)
- •Not allowed working places and categories
 - Any kind of teaching, teaching assistant, tutoring or lecturing activity is strictly prohibited
 - Working at manufacturing industry is strictly prohibited

(*In case of manufacturing industry, you are eligible to work only if you have TOPIK level 4.

According to 외국인 유학생 사증발급 및 체류관리 지침2019.03.04. 일부개정본)

- Working at construction (building) industry is strictly prohibited
- Students who are not allowed to do part time job
 - Student whose attendance rate is less than 70%
 - Student whose average academic grade is less than C (2.0)

Rules regarding part-time work

- •Final approval of your work will be made by the officer of immigration office. If you violate part-time work regulation,
 - Found your violation first time: you cannot do part time job for one year. Also, you will not be eligible to get D-10 visa for good.
 - Found your violation second time: your study permit will be canceled for good, and will be deported immediately.
 - In case you work at **construction (building) industry** illegally, there's no second chance. Once you get caught, you will be deported immediately. (one strike- out system)
